

MEET THE ARTIST

There's a lot that makes our **Studio Collection** special, but at the beating heart of it is our resident artist's hands.

Meet Aaron Hammond. With a background in tile design, he's been creating his own for 12 years, spending the last four running his own hand painted tile studio. In tandem with our Head of Creative Grazzie, they'll be designing micro collection after micro collection, coming up with concepts and stories together before Aaron's hand turns them into a marriage of classic techniques and modern making methods.

CONSTANT CURATION

Just like with every tile under the Ca' Pietra casa roof, the Studio Collection designs are the result of relentless eyeballing over what's going down in the world of fashion, the global luxury hotel game, pouring over art history and architectural tomes, and drawing inspiration from design details over the eras. "We lap up the lot, we put them into our very own mixing pot," says Grazzie, "From it we come out with designs that are completely and utterly unique to us, our world and your home. We care about designing firsts, originals – our own lens, always."

There are four collections launching between now and the end of the year – that's all part of the thrill of the Studio Collection: British production and constant curation means collections will be hitting hard and fast.

ARTISANAL, AND THEN SOME

The design story behind the Studio Collection isn't just a case of being created by a UK artist and formed in our Wiltshire studio, but a number of them are hand-painted, like Jamboree. The whole collection is fired in Britain too, keeping it as close to home as can be. "The Studio Collection is all about artistry and we knew that feeling of the arts had to be carried through in every sense. The art in the artisanal side of these tiles is one of its greatest traits," continued Grazzie.

MEET NONNA'S KITCHEN

Ten tiles. All destined for your walls. Each one as charming as the other. That's Nonna's Kitchen for you in a nutshell.









THE STORY

For one of our first collections to come out of Ca' Pietra Studio, we wanted to create a collection that transported you to someplace else – somewhere nostalgic, somewhere comforting, some place that breathes good food into the heart of your home before you've even got out the chopping board.

When we created Nonna's Kitchen we imagined them lining the walls of kitchens that are full of stories, sat against a farmhouse kitchen table and antique cabinetry that have been in the multigenerational family home for decades. And a Nonna, hand-making every shape pasta and every sauce you could imagine.



You might not have olive branches extending outside your window, but the soul of the Italian kitchen can still be brought into homes far and wide. From country cottages to period townhouses in the city, these are tiles that will live their days richly, encouraging you to bring in fresh cut flowers and fruit from the market in their crumpled brown paper bags, to always keep the fridge full for whoever descends, to cook fine fare with family and friends and to live the good life in the heart of your home.



THE DESIGNS

We've got florals, foliage and fruits. While they might be named Nonna's Kitchen, they translate to all parts of the home.

MEET JAMBOREE

Eight signature shades translated onto two square wall tile designs plus a dado, that's Jamboree.



THE STORY

Jamboree means a festival or party and that's exactly the feeling we wanted to capture with these tiles. The idea is you can mix and match them however you want, styling them up and accessorising them in a whole load of ways. It's a tile that wants you to express yourself.











THE DESIGNS

All designed for walls in any room of the home, Jamboree comes in two styles of square wall tile – one a block colour and the other a two-tone split – plus a dado to finish off a run of tiles or even divide things up in creative ways. They're all hand-painted in the UK and are seriously rich and glossy.



MEET BOBBIN

Square wall tiles decorated with a rise-and-fall scallop border, in five hues and all fired in the UK. That's Bobbin in a nutshell.





THE STORY

"Bobbin designs in furniture have been having a real moment for the past few seasons, and that's where our Bobbin tile story starts," continues Aaron. "It might be a look that's been around since the 17th-century but it's modern-day craftsmen like Alfred Newall who has been leading the charge in bringing the bobbin back in lampstands, shelving stems, mirror surrounds and even bed frames. We found ourselves thinking, but what about on tiles? And the rest is history."

THE DESIGNS

The bobbin decorative technique is classically a 3D thing where its bobbled form can be appreciated from all angles. We took the idea of the bobbin and followed its undulating side profile to form a scalloped border on a simple white glazed tile to give you pattern and colour but in a restrained, heritage way.
